# MISSION:

Buckhead Heritage strives to sustain the quality of life in Buckhead by identifying, preserving, restoring, and promoting its historic resources. We endeavor to foster a conscious respect within the community for its rich and diverse history, ensuring that Buckhead's history is accommodated in future growth and is secured for the benefit of future generations.

# **VISION:**

A thriving community that values its rich historic fabric, promotes sustainable residential and commercial development, and enjoys its quality of life.

# **GUIDING PRINCIPLES:**

We are guided in our work by four core principles:

- 1. Citizens who are educated on the history of their community are more likely to take a proprietary interest in their community and find value in its resources.
- 2. Communities that value historic preservation are inherently better places for living.
- 3. The history of a community is directly responsible for shaping the character of that community; the development pattern of a community is the evidence of its history and is defined by its historic structures and landscapes.
- 4. If Buckhead's history is not preserved and recorded, it will be lost.

#### **INDICATORS OF SUCCESS:**

We succeed to the extent that a thriving Buckhead community respects and retains its historic resources and that its residents are aware and proud of the heritage of their community.

# **SELECT OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Complete Harmony Grove project and determine best ways to announce its successful completion
- 2. Work with neighborhoods to promote their historic resources, potentially through Centennial celebrations
- 3. Undertake additional preservation projects and complete in an expert fashion
- 4. Initiate a comprehensive historic resources inventory for the 42 neighborhoods of Buckhead
- 5. Explore opportunities to get a university class or students involved in conducting the inventory
- 6. Review Buckhead boundaries for the purpose of the organization, and prioritize areas of focus
- 7. Seek opportunities to tell "stories" in schools and other venues, and seek opportunities to take groups "out" to experience the resources
- 8. Initiate Oral History Project to capture and document oral histories of Buckhead residents
- 9. Assist landowners in listing their properties on the National Register of Historic Places
- 10. Assist landowners in using conservation easements and façade easements to protect their significant properties
