Comparison

- Calculate neighborhood averages and show relative comparisons while maintaining privacy Note: Studies have shown that this kind of peer comparison is effective at persuading people to reduce their resource consumption

Competition

Objective – motivate members by using this information to set up competitions between neighborhoods and other groups

- Use comparison data to set up competing groups (schools, churches, clubs, etc.)
- Groups challenge each other to reduce resource use
- Group results are tracked and winners recognized
- Create a competitive, fun dynamic which encourages and challenges all groups to lower their resource usage
