
- Mass Grading through June 26







ATLANTA BUREAU OF POLICE SERVICES - POLICE ACADEMY

In early 1974, a group of Atlanta Police Officers, realizing the need for a vehicle for professionalization of the Bureau, transported four portable buildings, unusable by normal standards, purchased from the Atlanta Board of Education for one dollar (\$1.00), to the Key Road area. This was the beginning of the Atlanta Police Academy. Materials, funds and manpower were limited or non-existent but by careful spending, utilization of begged, borrowed, and found materials, C.E.T.A manpower and the dedication of some talented police officers, these four portables now present a proud foundation for the facility which we hope to have. Seeing what was accomplished, the Atlanta Bureau of Police Club and Honor Guard pledged their finances to assist in its completion. To date there is approximately \$150,000.00 manpower and material investment in the Key Road facility.
